We pulled into the church's parking lot to find their Prayer Station in full operation - praying for people as we arrived. Upcoming Ministry

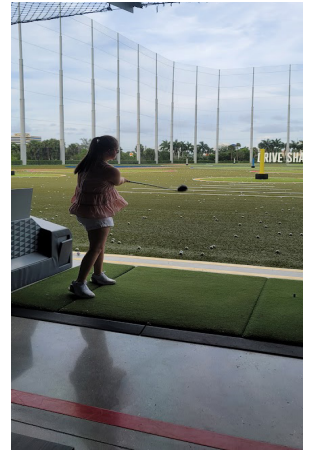

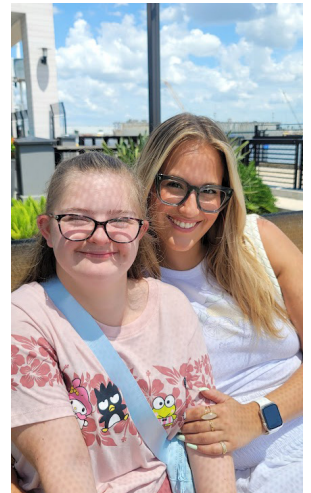

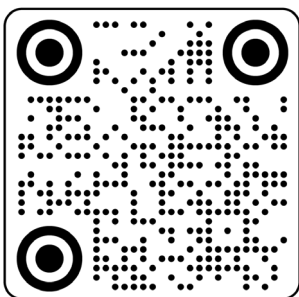
